SPORTSMANSHIP AND SPECTATOR CONDUCT

The pursuit of good sportsmanship is the goal of the Classic 8 Conference. Coaches, athletes, cheerleaders, support groups, and fans are expected to display good sportsmanship at all games and functions.

In order to foster a positive outlook amongst athletes, coaches and fans, while keeping in perspective the purpose of the game, the following guidelines have been adopted by the Classic 8 Conference.

SPECTATORS

1. May not bring stereo tape decks and related radio equipment into facilities holding games or meets.
2. Noisemakers and inappropriate paraphernalia of any kind are prohibited.
3. Any remarks and/or dress directed at an athlete, coach, official or meet management which are racial, ethnic, profane, discriminating or demeaning may result in removal from the game or meet site.

BANNERS

Banners must be hand held and stationary. These banners **may not** have offensive language, be used to disrupt players or officials, interfere with spectators or be carried around the facility during an event. Banners may not be hung from balconies, ceilings, etc. Permanent banners of the host school are allowed. At outdoor events, banners may be displayed with the approval of game management.

CHEERLEADING

Shakers and pennants for spectators, cheerleaders and pom pon squads are allowed, even if attached to wooden/plastic sticks. "Homer Hankies", towels and "hands" with "no.1 finger" are permitted. These items are subject to the following restrictions: (a) They may contain no printing except school name, team nickname and/or mascot, (b) game management has the authority to prohibit them if they cause crowd control problems. Only authorized cheerleaders will be permitted to lead cheers. Schools are prohibited from using cheers which ridicule an opponent or are otherwise in bad taste. Each school is responsible for the nature of its cheers.

PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES/MATERIALS

No alcoholic beverages may be available or present at high school events. No tobacco or tobacco products shall be used at a high school event.
